Any entrepreneur who has a company registered in Brazil or has been operating for seven years or less, has generated actual or estimated revenue between US\$1 million and US\$15 million or raised at least US\$500 thousand in equity can take part in the award. Ten startups will be selected for the next phase and only one will represent Brazil in the global finals - KPMG Director and Leader of the Emerging Giants Program, Diogo Garcia.

Mentor Hour - Two KPMG experts have been invited by Web Summit Rio to mentor startups at the Mentor Hours program. It consists of a series of pre-scheduled one-hour meetings and eight startups will be trained as a group. The meetings will take place at Pavilion 3.
